## E-Safety Jargon Buster..

A firewall is a tool which checks information coming into or going out of a network/computer to see if it meets pre-determined criteria. If the criteria aren't met, the information will be rejected by the firewall. Many schools have firewalls to protect pupils from inappropriate content
