Do you really know what apps your child has on their tablet or phone? Have a look! Have you set up the restrictions? If they have access to their own social media accounts or blog, please talk to them about what should and should not be shared online, and have agreed that before they post anything they ask themselves the following:

Is it something I am happy for my friends to read?

Is it about anyone other than me?

Would Mum/Dad/School approve?

Does it contain personal information – define personal as information about where we live, their school (if a blog post) and anything body or health related. If the answer to the top three is No or the last question Yes, ideally they should check with you before posting.
